

Called Church Business Meeting Sunday, June 27, 2021

Dr. Dennis Wiles, Pastor and moderator, called the church into business session at 9:32 AM in the Classic Worship Service, Sunday, June 27, 2021.

Dr. Dennis Wiles stated that the purpose for the called business sessions during the 8:30 AM and 11:00 AM worship services was to present a new course for Soteria Counseling and Family Services.

David Luningham, Chair of the Soteria Board of Directors, made the following recommendation:

The Board of Directors of Soteria Counseling and Family Services recommends that First Baptist Arlington enter into an agreement with The Center for Integrative Counseling and Psychology to provide counseling service. This agreement will be approved by the Legal Committee of First Baptist Church.

A vote was taken. The business session was suspended at 9:38 AM to be reconvened during the 11:00 AM Contemporary Worship Service.

The business for the day having been completed, Dr. Wiles asked for a motion to adjourn. Wade Berry moved to adjourn. Terry Cunningham seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 11:18 AM.

The prior process was repeated and April Ott stated the motions again. A vote was taken in the meeting and online.

The ballot tabulations showed 592 for and 1 against approving the recommendation to establish the new position, Minister to Adults. The ballot tabulations showed 606 for and 1 against approving the recommendation to approve the proposed members of the Search Committee for Minister to Adults. Both recommendations were approved.

After the voting, April Ott announced Katy Reed Hodges as the candidate for the new position of Minister of Congregational Life. The Church will vote on her candidacy on June 6, 2021.

The business for the day having been completed, Dr. Wiles asked for a motion to adjourn. Jeff Kennemer moved to adjourn. Marla Johnson seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 12:13 PM.

Dr. Dennis Wiles stated that the purpose for the called business session during the 9:30 AM worship service was to present the proposed new 2021-22 budget and to seek approval for World Mission Offering goal for 2021-2022 fiscal year and the distribution of the funds. He noted that information about both proposals was posted on the church wed site.

Dr. Wiles called upon Stacy Williams, Chair of the 2021-22 Finance Committee, to present the motion for approval of First Baptist Church of Arlington's budget for fiscal year 2021-2022.

Stacy Williams moved that the First Baptist Church of Arlington Fiscal Year 2021-2022 budget that totals \$7,985,000 be approved.

The vote tabulation showed 477 for and 5 against approval of the proposed 2021-2022 budget. The proposed budget was approved.

Dr. Wiles asked Steve Leist, Chair of the 2020-21 The Great Commission Council, to present the motion for approval.

Steven Leist moved that the church approve the recommended World Mission Offering goal of \$250,000 for the FY 2021/2022 and that the funds be distributed as follows:

The ballot tabulation showed 514 for and 6 against approval of the proposed FBCA staff position: *Minister of Congregational Life. The staff position* was approved.

Dr. Wiles called for a motion to adjourn. Aubrey Johnson moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Frank Engle.

Jeff Williams read the recommendation: The Master Planning Committee recommends beginning the fourth segment of Phase I of the FBCA Master Plan by awarding a general contracting contract to PRIM Construction for a not-to-exceed amount of \$2.520M plus an additional \$0.47M of miscellaneous costs for a grand total of \$2.99M.

A vote was taken from those attending the service. Those joining the service virtually (on line) were given the opportunity to vote.

The ballot tabulation showed 643 for and 3 against. The recommendation was approved.

A motion to adjourn was made by Pat Prewett. The motion was seconded by Shirley graves. The motion to adjourn was approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:50 AM.

Third Quarter 2019-2020 Church Conference Wednesday Evening, March 4, 2020

Dr. Dennis Wiles, Senior Pastor and moderator, convened the Third Quarter 2019-2020 Church Conference, Wednesday evening, March 4, 2020 at 6:15 PM.

➤ Dr. Wiles first called attention to the packet of information noting the minutes for the Second Quarter 2019-2020 Church Conference, Wednesday, November 6, 2019. A correction was made in the signature block – "Second" to "First."

Dan Dalton moved that the quarterly minutes be approved as corrected. The motion was seconded by James Lanmon. **The motion was approved.**

➤ Dr. Wiles directed attention to the Membership Reports including NorthPointe which reflected adjustments to membership through a request for letters, drops, and the addition of new members. He asked for a motion to approve requests for new memberships, adjustments to the membership record and the granting of letters.

Sheryl Smith moved to approve the requests for new memberships, adjustments to the membership record and the granting of letters. The motion was seconded by Laura Hawkins. **The motion was approved.**

> Dr. Wiles introduced Bill Darroch, Chair of the Committee on Committees, who introduced the Committee's members. He then presented the slate of church committees with their proposed new members for the fiscal year 2020-21.

Bill Darroch moved that the recommended committee memberships for 2020-21 be approved. (The list of committees and their members is attached to these minutes.)

The motion was approved.

➤ Cheryl Smith, Cahir of the Great Commission Council, presented the recommendation for the giving goal for the fiscal year 2020-21. After reviewing recent giving and assessing current needs the Council decided to maintain the current goal.

Sheryl Smith moved to set the World Mission Offering goal at \$225,000 for the 2020-21 fiscal year. **The motion was approved.**

Sheryl Smith continued, explaining the changes in specific budget allocations. The recommended allocations for the 2020-21 fiscal year are:

- ➤ Dr. Wiles then recognized Brandee Kelly, Vice Chair of the Finance Committee for 2019-2020, for a report on the financial status of the church. Ms. Kelley presented the following report.
 - 3rd Qtr. FY 2019-2020 Operating Budget Receipts and Expenses: Receipts for the quarter were \$3,204,371. This was over budget by \$694,371. Year-to-date income of \$5,930,735 was \$310,735 over budget. Operating expenses for the quarter were \$1,836,139. Actual expenses were over budgeted expenses by \$764. Year-to-date expenses of \$5,161,199 were \$325,296 under budget.
 - 3rd Qtr. FY 2019-2020 Balance Sheet on December 31, 2019: There wasn't a balance sheet reported.
 - 3rd Qtr. FY 2019-2020 Non-Budgeted Accounts Balance: The restricted, designated and fee-based funds balance on December 31, 2019 was \$2,841,064.49.
 - 3rd Qtr. 2019-2020 Child Development Center CDC revenues for the quarter were \$300,003. Expenses were \$291,617. Quarterly income was over expenses by \$8,386. Year-to-date income of \$839,892 was \$21,243 under budget. Year-to-date expenses of \$823,523 were \$76,010 under budget.

• 3rd Qtr. 2019-2020 – Blessing the Generations. Total income for the quarter was \$606,436.24 which included investment earnings of \$746.03. The accumulative income was \$22,658,140.03 which includes a loan draws of \$9,397,670.42. Total expenses for the quarter were \$59,467.23. The accumulative expenses were \$21,785,772.60. The balance in the account was \$872,367.43.

Brandee Kelly, on behalf of the Finance Committee, moved to accept the financial report as presented. **The motion was approved.**

Brandee Kelly presented the proposed budget for fiscal year 2020-21. She enumerated the many considerations that went into preparing the budget. There was a question and answer period. No action was taken. The proposed budget will be voted upon at both worship services on March 8, 2020.

> Dr. Wiles called for a motion to adjourn the business meeting. Terry Bertrand moved to adjourn and Gary Steele seconded the motion.

The motion was approved.

The meeting was adjourned by Dr. Wiles at 7:11PM.
