VOCABULARY: *What do these words mean?*

Journey: *The English Translation of the Bible uses the word “walk” over 200 times. Often this word is used to represent the nature of our relationship with God.*

○ **Genesis 5:24**

○ **Genesis 17:1**

○ **Psalm 1:1**

○ **Jeremiah 6:16**

Sacramental: *This English word is derived from the Latin word, sacramentum. The root of this Latin term is sacrare- which means “to consecrate.” It has at its root the idea of holiness or sacred. When the Septuagint (Greek translation of the Old Testament - LXX - and the Greek New Testament were translated into Latin in the Vulgate, sacramentum was the translation of the Greek term musterion (mystery).*
