## FACTS OF THE RESURRECTION

- Jesus died on the cross.
- Jesus was buried in a borrowed tomb while “the women” watched.
- The tomb was sealed, and guards were posted.
- Early on Sunday morning, women came to anoint the Body of Jesus.
- The stone had been removed earlier that morning.
- The tomb was empty!
- Angelic messengers announced the resurrection of Jesus!
- The women gave testimony to the disciples.
- Peter and John visited the empty tomb.
- The resurrected Jesus appeared to both individuals and groups of people.
- Jesus continued to teach His disciples.
- Jesus promised the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Jesus commissioned His disciples.
- Jesus ascended into heaven!
