“Time” in the New Testament

- Kronos -measured time
- Kairos- meaningful time
- Hora- hour, specifically used by John in an eschatological sense
- Eschaton- end times
- Aion- Age

This Present Age - marked by sin, brokenness, separation, and finite temporal duration.

The Age to Come - the Kingdom of God, fully consummated, and initiated by the Messiah's arrival.

INAUGURATED ESCHATOLOGY: The Age to Come has intersected This Present Age. We are now the New Covenant People of God!

Galatians 1:3-4: We have been rescued from this present evil age.

1 Corinthians 10:11: The “ends” of the ages has already arrived!

Jesus announced, “The Kingdom of God has come near!”
(Matthew 4:17; Mark 1:14-15)

Luke 22:20: The New Covenant has arrived, sealed by Christ’s blood.

Hebrews 8: The New Covenant has rendered the Old Covenant obsolete.

2 Corinthians 3:7-18: The glory of the New Covenant is unfading and surpasses the glory of the Old Covenant.

The Present Age and The Age to Come are both successive and concurrent!
