## THE CONFUSION IN CORINTH

The issue in Corinth surrounding the resurrection from the dead was not the result of a rebellious spirit. It seems to have stemmed from genuine confusion. In 1 Corinthians 15:12 - Paul states the issue: "How can some of you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?" He reiterates the Corinthian confusion in v. 35 - "How are the dead raised?"
