CREATION: Genesis 5 opens with a summary of creation:

- God created mankind in His image
- He created them male and female
- He blessed them
- He called them “man” - “Adam”

NEW BEGINNING: Genesis 5 marks a new beginning for humanity in contrast to the descent of humanity traced through the lineage of Cain in Genesis 4.

BLESSING AND CURSE: Genesis 5 is marked by both the blessing of procreation (hope of the seed of the woman) and the curse of death.

ENOCH: The seventh generation from Adam through Seth is focused on the story of Enoch. Enoch demonstrates the beauty of walking with God and a reminder of God’s original design for humanity.

LAMECH: Moses records the contrasting stories of the legacy of Lamech through Cain’s lineage and the legacy of Lamech through the lineage of Seth.

NOAH: Noah represents the hope of God's comfort and an answer to the curse.

ANTEDILUVIAN PERIOD: This period in history is marked by longevity in human life, the blessing of God through procreation, the hope of humanity, and the reminder of the pervasiveness of the curse.
