THE TEXT: What Happened?

- The wickedness of humanity (6:5, 11-12)
- God's heart was wounded (6:6-7)
- God decided to bring judgment and restore His creation (6:7, 12-13, 17)
- Noah was righteous, blameless, and he walked with God (6:8-9)
- God gave Noah instructions to build an ark (6:14-16)
- God gave instructions concerning the rescue of both creatures and Noah's family (6:19-7:4)
- God established a covenant with Noah (6:18)
- God flooded the world (7:13-24)
- God remembered Noah (8:1)
- The flood receded (8:1-14)
- Noah's family left the ark (8:15-19)
- Noah offered up sacrifices to God (8:20)
- God promised to never destroy the world (8:21-9:17)

THEOLOGICAL REFLECTION: What Does It All Mean?

1. God notices and blesses righteousness!
2. God judges unrighteousness!
3. Noah and Adam: Creation, Un-Creation, and Re-Creation.

4. Noah and Moses: Righteous figures of redemption.

5. God is a covenant-making and covenant-honoring God!

6. God's grace is always on display through His redemptive judgment.
