REDEMPTIVE HISTORY/FATHER ABRAHAM

ABRAHAM'S JOURNEY OF FAITH (Genesis 11:27-25:11)

The heart of this story is the chronicling of Abraham's faith journey and the stewarding of the promise of an heir. It is not a simple recounting of world history. It is primarily theological and spiritual in its orientation.

SARAI'S PLOT (Genesis 16:1-6)

- Sarai is barren and desperate.
- Sarai takes matters into her own hands.
- Abram consents (much like Adam).
- Sarai "took" and "gave" (much like Eve).
- Hagar became pregnant.
- Sarai responded to the "success of her plot" with disdain and anger.
- Hagar fled for her life.

GOD'S INTERVENTION (Genesis 16:7-16)

- Hagar fled toward Egypt.
- The Angel of the LORD
- God's direction to Hagar was to return to Sarai and submit to her.
- God's promise concerning Ishmael
- Hagar gives God a name --- the only time this occurs in the Bible.
- Hagar has a son and Abram names him, Ishmael.

ABRAM'S JOURNEY OF FAITH

- 1. The promise from God remains intact but unfulfilled.
- 2. The promise now has a new threat—a rival heir.
- 3. Sarai's seeming lack of faith has introduced many unintended consequences.
- 4. Ishmael and his descendants will serve as rivals to Isaac and his descendants (Genesis 21, 25).
- 5. The Apostle Paul will draw upon the rivalry between Hagar and Sarah in his theological development (Galatians 4).
- 6. Ishmael will become the son of promise in the theology of Islam.
