REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT INFO

Registration is through the Parent Dashboard. You will log in at fbca.org/registration with your account (or create a new family profile!). Once logged in, click Enrollment in the taskbar on the left side. Click Enroll for 2023-2024 for the student you are enrolling. Type witness in the yellow passcode box, then click Submit Passcode.. Culture & Witness Week will appear on the right side. Click Add Option, then Save & Continue to begin your registration.

The cost of the week is \$50. This includes your training materials, lunch, refreshments, and transportation.

FOCUS & OBJECTIVES

These four days will be focused on several important things:

Growing in biblical apologetics

- Understanding our church's context for missions and evangelism
- Cultural education about the religion of Islam
- Cultivating a heart for our Muslim neighbors
- Developing strategies for real life connections with our Muslim neighbors, classmates, and friends to bridge the Gospel.

SCHEDULE

We will begin at <u>9am</u> each morning in the Chapel for training. Parents are welcome to use the drop off drive to drop off students!

Our training will be led by several key leaders from the field, including: Ashley Berryhill, FBCA Cross Cultural Minister, Luke Stehr, FBCA Community Engagement Coordinator, Guillermo and Emily, FBCA Cross Cultural Workers in Spain, and Bud with Global Gates.

Lunch will be provided each day, either at the church or at an area restaurant where students will have the opportunity to encounter other cultures and cuisines. There will be "safe food" anywhere we go, and snacks will also be available throughout the day. The cost of lunch is included in your registration.

After lunch, students will participate in different hands-on activities to put what we've learned into practice. This may include prayer walking predominantly Muslim neighborhoods, a scavenger hunt at the market, projects for various organizations that care for Muslims in our community, and a visit to the mosque. A more detailed schedule will be sent before Culture & Witness Week begins with any details you need to know!

The day will conclude by 4:30pm, and students may be picked up from the Chapel.

WHAT TO BRING

- Bible and pen
- Any medications your student may need, such as an inhaler or Epipen
- Comfortable shoes for walking
- Cool clothes for spending time working and/or being outdoors
- Long pants or skirt and a head covering (such as a scarf) for our mosque visit
