MING PEOPLE OF CHINA 15,100 PEOPLE / 0% EVANGELICAL

Even the Buddhist temples are empty in China's Maoxian County! An entire generation has received an atheistic education, and now the Ming people ridicule any religious beliefs. This younger generation mocks their parents' animistic or Buddhist beliefs, calling them "superstitious."

Years ago, these people of mixed ancestry faced prejudice. Since the Han Chinese didn't accept them socially, the Ming people adopted a separate identity, wearing distinct clothing and forming their own villages.

Teams of Christians who try to distribute gospel literature face arrest. Will the more than 15,000 Ming people living in this region ever hear of salvation through Christ?
