THE PLAN

God laid out the plan for Moses. He is planning to deliver Israel from slavery in Egypt. The leaders of Israel will be ready to hear from Moses. God will intervene in the relationship with Pharaoh. Finally, Israel - in fact, Israeli women! - will plunder the Egyptians!

MOSES - NOT READY

In spite of God's assurances, Moses remained unconvinced. He wondered about the response of Israel's leaders.

POWER - GOD IS UNMATCHED

God demonstrated to Moses through several signs that His power will be the key to the success of the plan. Moses will play a strategic role as the messenger and the catalyst for deliverance. However, God's power will be on display!

MOSES - SELF-DOUBT

Moses remained unconvinced. His lack of self-confidence seems to be at the heart of his resistance.

MOSES - DISOBEDIENCE-RELUCTANCE-OBEDIENCE

Moses requested God send someone else! God's plan was to use Moses. He was singularly qualified for this role (education, knowledge of Egypt, relationships, encounter with God, etc.). God's patience wore thin, and He gave Moses a partner - Aaron. Moses finally chose to obey.
