OPPOSITION TO JESUS INTENSIFIES Matthew 12

CONTEXT

- Identity of Jesus Son of Abraham, Son of King David, Son of God, Messiah, Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews (Matthew 1-3)
- Core Message of Jesus "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near." (Matthew 4:17)
- Discipleship Standards Matthew 5-7
- Authority of Jesus Matthew 8-9
- Jesus now sends His disciples/apostles forth into a Mission that still has deep ramifications for His followers today! (Matthew 10)
- The growing opposition to Jesus is recorded in Matthew 11-12.

THE MOUNTING OPPOSITION

In the first century, Jewish leaders were fiercely loyal to what they considered to be the most sacred things: the temple, the ceremonial law, and the Sabbath. As Jesus engaged in ministry across Galilee in particular, Jewish leaders perceived Jesus as a threat to all three of these. He also had to deal with doubt from John the Baptist and distractions from His family.

- Matthew 11:1-5 John the Baptist sent messengers to Jesus to question Him about His identity as the Messiah.
- Matthew 11:20-24 Even the towns in Galilee that witnessed His miracles struggled to embrace Him in repentance.
- Matthew 12:2 Jesus was accused of allowing His disciples to violate the Sabbath laws.
- Matthew 12:14 The Pharisees began to plan to kill Jesus.

- Matthew 12:24 The Pharisees accused Jesus of being in partnership with the demonic leader Beelzebul.
- Matthew 12:38 The Pharisees and teachers of the Law demanded to see a sign from Jesus.
- Matthew 12:46-50 The family of Jesus had to adjust their relationship to Him.
